## **Online Entries will be available at [www.horseshowsonline.com](http://www.horseshowsonline.com)**

What you need: A free account at HorseShowsOnline. If you don't already have an account you can create one when you click the continue button below. HorseShowsOnline basic member is FREE. A record in your account for each person and horse that you will use on show entry forms when you enter a show.

How do I get started: Login to HorseShowsOnline by clicking the "Member Services" button in the main menu OR click the continue button below. Once you are logged in, click the "My Horses, People, Shows" button in the member menu. At the People, Horses, Shows page, add any new people and horses to your account as required on the appropriate tab (IE: My People, My Horses). People and horses are saved with your account. Once you have those records in your account you can use them at every show you enter. Click the "Enter show" button to select the show you want to enter and follow the steps in the online entry wizard.

Steps to enter a show: Select the show you want to enter from your "My People, Horses, Shows" page on the "My Show Entries" tab or find the show you want to enter in show selector and click the Online Entry icon. This will start the online entry wizard. Make sure you have already created the horses and people in your member account. The online entry wizard will guide you through the steps to complete the entry form. The basic steps in the wizard are: Select the horse, people and riders for your entry. Select the classes each rider is entered in. Select the quantity for stalls and other fees. Confirm your selections. Checkout and submit the show entry. The final step generates the completed entry form and submits your entry to the show for review and acceptance. If the show requires a payment at entry time, you will be prompted for your credit card information.

Tips: You can cancel the entry part way through the wizard and resume the entry later on. For example, if you need to add more people to your account or you just want to come back and complete the entry later. Unfinished entry forms are listed in your "My entries" tab and will allow you to edit the entry. People and horses you create in your account are saved permanently and can be used in other shows you enter. You only need to add people and horses once and then they can be re-used.

Do not attempt to correct your entry online once it has been submitted. Corrections will have to be done through the mail or at the horse show office.

Even though you made your entries online, you are still required to follow normal entry rules, i.e. copies of registration papers, Coggins, membership copies, measurement card copies, etc. should be mailed by entry closing date.

Payment must be US Postal marked and mailed by entry closing date to avoid late penalty fees.

**On Saturday morning, an hour of quiet time will be observed, from 8:00 am-9:00 am, to allow Academy riders warm-up time in the show arena before the start of the Academy session. Show horses may practice in Ring 2 during this time.**

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

**REMINDER:** If your horse/pony is owned by a corporation, farm, entity or LLC, that corporation, farm, entity or LLC must hold a membership to USEF. If a person is owner of the above, USEF will not count that as a membership. You must use the proper form on the USEF site to record and pay for a corporation, farm or LLC membership or pay a show fee.

GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule 1. At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Copies of documentation must be submitted with entries.

Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current US Equestrian Federation Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

The Blowing Rock Charity Horse Show Committee reserves the right to itself of declining to receive any exhibitor and/or horse to show and the right to order from the grounds any exhibitor, horse or groom, without penalty or compensation.

**ENTRIES** must be postmarked by May 24, 2021 to avoid a late penalty. Entries will not be accepted over the telephone. All entry blanks must be properly signed by an adult. All horses will be charged a non-refundable office fee of \$25 per horse. All horses or ponies must have either a horse ID number issued from US Equestrian Federation or a breed registration number in order to show. This number must be listed on the entry blank.

**POST ENTRIES** - Entries postmarked after May 24, 2021, will be charged a post entry fee of \$20 per horse. This will be in addition to all other normal fees. Horses and/or ponies must be entered in a class or will be considered a post entry. Entries will be accepted up to one hour before the scheduled start of each session. An unsigned open check mailed with entries will be considered as a post entry. Entries without payment will also be considered a post entry and late fees will apply.

**EMERGENCY ENTRIES** - In cases where entries cannot be made at least one hour before the scheduled start of each session, an emergency penalty of \$30.00 will be charged for each class in addition to all other fees.

**STALL FEES** are \$110.00 per stall. All stalls are permanent with full doors. Stalls will be ready for occupancy on Tuesday, June 8, 2021 at 8:00 am. Arrangements can be made for earlier arrival through the Manager at an additional fee of \$15.00 per day per stall. Stall fees must accompany entry form. **EXTRA CHARGES FOR REMOVAL OR ALTERING DOORS.** A \$25 perhorse grounds fee will be charged for all horses showing out of their trailer.

**INITIAL BEDDING** will NOT be provided. Only bag shavings will be available for purchase from the show through the horse show office or the grounds & feed person. Bedding can be ordered by filling out the space provided on the entry blank and your bedding will be at your stalls when you arrive. You may call LIZ HOLMES @ 919-672-3741 prior to the week of the show. The week of the show call 828-295-4700. Feed and hay will be available. Please note on entry blank your arrival date and time. **NEITHER BEDDING NOR FEED MAY BE BROUGHT IN BY AN OUTSIDE VENDOR.** Neither bark nor sawdust will be allowed to be hauled in from the outside. If an outside vendor hauls in bedding or feed for a client of his, he will be charged a show vendor fee. Persons wanting to bring their own bedding may do so but must haul it in on their own vehicles.

**HORSE SHOW OFFICE** will close one hour prior to the scheduled starting time of each performance for taking entries for that performance. Any scratches after this time will be accepted but entries fees will be retained. An emergency entry fee of \$30.00 per class added will be charged in addition to the normal entry fee.

**REFUNDS** of Entry Fees will only be made upon presentation of a certificate of illness issued by a veterinarian on an official letterhead stating illness or lameness. Fees will be refunded minus a \$15.00 scratch horse fee, the non-refundable office fee per horse and the post entry fee. Requests for stall refunds after May 29, 2021, will not be honored.

**EMERGENCY REFUND POLICY** in the event all or part of the competition is cancelled due to a storm, accident or other emergency. If the competition is cancelled prior to the scheduled first day of the horse show all fees will be refunded in full minus the non-refundable office fee. Stall fees will not be refunded after May 29, 2021. If classes are cancelled once the competition has begun, entry fees for remaining classes will be refunded.

**THE BLOWING ROCK CHARITY HORSE SHOW will not be held liable for any accident, loss, damage or injury that may occur to any Exhibitor, Owner, Trainer, Agent, Groom, Individual or Spectator sustained while at the Blowing Rock Charity Horse Show. This shall be incorporated as a condition of entry or admittance to the Show.**

**ACCOUNTS:** All accounts must be paid at the Horse Show Office before entry numbers will be given out. A signed, open check must be left for each account in the office prior to packets being distributed. An unsigned, open check sent in with entries will be cause to consider entries as post entries. The Horse Show office WILL NOT be open on Monday following the show. Accounts must be settled before the last class of the Sunday afternoon performance.

Anyone failing to settle their account will relinquish the right for adjustments. It will be to your advantage to check over your account before filling in your check.

**FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT:** By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Blowing Rock Charity Horse Show (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

**VAN AND TRAILER PARKING WILL BE OFF-SITE.** Get map and site location of trailers and vans at horse show office. Motor Homes or Campers will be charged \$40.00 per day.

**NORTH CAROLINA requires a negative "Coggins" Certificate,** within 12 months of entering into or leaving the State. ALL HORSES MUST HAVE CURRENT COGGINS TEST. A COPY MUST BE KEPT WITH HORSE. A copy must also be sent with entries and left on file in the horse show office.

THREE ENTRIES are required to fill a class. Fewer than three may be cause for cancellation or combining the class, at the option of the management.

**USEF FEE & DRUG FEE/NON-MEMBER SHOW PASS FEE:** USEF Federation fee \$23.00 {\$15.00 Drug & Medication, \$8.00 USEF). A non-member may compete by paying a \$45.00 non-member show pass fee. All non-members must furnish the show secretary with a mailing address. Amateurs may not show as non-members, they must apply for membership with amateur certification.

**REGISTRATION PAPERS:** A copy of Registration Papers showing current ownership must accompany each horse and/or pony entered in the American Saddlebred Division, the Hackney/Hackney Harness Pony division. WE MUST KEEP A COPY ON FILE IN THE SHOW OFFICE AND THESE COPIES WILL NOT BE RETURNED. Numbers will not be released for an entry in these divisions without the proper proof of registration. Names of horses/ ponies must be on the Entry Form. The word "Entry" may not be used. All horses/ponies must be entered in their full registered name and number and in the current owner of record.

**PRIZE MONEY** will be mailed within 30 days after the close of show. Prize money will be credited to the agents account. Persons wishing to receive their own prize money must send in separate entry blank with current agent information listed including social security number.

**RETURNED CHECKS will be charged a \$50.00 return check fee.**

**FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT:** By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Blowing Rock Charity Horse Show (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

**QUESTIONS not covered by the Rules of the US Equestrian Federation shall be decided by Show Management.**

**FOOTING** in the Show Ring is a dirt base with a mix of mixed sand. Size of ring is 120 x 240'. Two warm-up rings are provided. Size of these are 120' x 238' and the 2nd is 110'x 220'. The warm-up rings have excellent footing and each has a similar base as the main show ring.

**MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

## ACADEMY DIVISION

The purpose of this division is to introduce potential owners to the joys of showing horses and give riders the opportunity to gain experience in a fun horse show atmosphere. The AMERICAN SADDLEBRED ASSOCIATION OF THE CAROLINAS sanctions these classes. A complete copy of the rules and regulations governing these classes are available at the horse show office.

▪RIDERS: Riders in this division are students who are enrolled in a professionally operated program and are to be judged on their basic riding skills. Riding suits are NOT allowed; Jodhpur boots and pants are suggested. Safety helmets are the only acceptable headgear for academy riders and are required for ALL17 and under riders. Riders may NOT cross enter into any performance classes with the exception of driving classes & Show Rider Classes. A rider who has shown in a performance division class or in show attire appropriate for any discipline WITHIN THE LAST 10 YEARS is prohibited from further participation in the Academy division except for Academy Show Rider Classes.

▪HORSES: Horse are to be lesson type horses! These horses must display the characteristics of such! Shoeing to allow a one-ply leather pad only with a flat/traditional/TS type/ keg shoe with no lead/additions/additional welds OR a country pleasure shoe (with no type pad) as described in USEF SB Rules. Equipaks are still allowed. Barns in violation of this rule will be disqualified from the academy division for the remainder of the season (with no ASAC High Points).

▪A rider may show his/her horse if the horse is REGULARLY used in a lesson program. If the horse is privately owned, this horse must be used for more lessons and be shown by other riders per show than only for the said owners. Horses must not be in training. Horses may be shown in a snaffle bridle with martingale or a Pelham/full bridle. Blinkers not allowed in under saddle classes. Polo wraps/run downs are prohibited/ protective boots are allowed. Flat cutback English saddles are to be used. Hoof-blackening is optional and ribbon braids are NOT allowed. Horses may cross-enter into the performance division at unrecognized show only (equitation at any show). HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED.

If you have a question about the ASAC Academy Rules please contact your UPHA Rep, UPHA Chapter Chair or ASAC Academy Committee Chairs. Horses in violation of these rules will result in disqualification of all academy entries at this show from barn of horse in violation.

▪While rules may be different in other states, horses from programs outside of the Carolinas MUST abide by these rules at ASAC sanctioned shows in North & South Carolina. Anyone not abiding by these rules, or horses deemed to be a danger, will be eliminated by authority of Horse Show Management, UPHA Chapter 12 Representatives/Officers or ASAC Officers/Directors.
