RULES AND REGULATIONS

USEF SHOW PASS: Currently, riders competing in Academy, Walk/Trot and Opportunity classes are exempt from USEF membership. Riders in these classes <u>will continue</u> to be exempt from membership. Riders and owners are eligible for one (1) Show Pass per competition year. Trainers and coaches <u>are no longer eligible</u> to compete under a Show Pass and <u>must</u> be Active USEF members.

Competitions cannot accept payment for a Show Pass. Purchases MUST be made online at www.usef.org/show-pass. A Show Pass is only valid for one (1) competition and non-member participants are limited to obtaining no more than one (1) Show Pass per competition year.

SAFE SPORT: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org USEF. USEF thanks you for participating in this competition and your support of USEF's continuous efforts to provide the safest environment possible for our athletes and other participants. *Safe Sport Training must be completed prior to the first day of competition.*

REMINDER: If your horse/pony is owned by a corporation, farm, entity or LLC, that corporation, farm, entity or LLC must hold a membership to USEF. If a person is owner of the above, USEF will not count that as a membership. You must use the proper form on the USEF site to record and pay for a corporation, farm or LLC membership or pay a show fee.

GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule 1. At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Copies of documentation must be submitted with entries.

Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current US Equestrian Federation Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

The Blowing Rock Charity Horse Show Committee reserves the right to itself of declining to receive any exhibitor and/or horse to show and the right to order from the grounds any exhibitor, horse or groom, without penalty or compensation.

ENTRIES must be postmarked by May 24, 2024, to avoid a late penalty. Entries will not be accepted over the telephone. All entry blanks must be properly signed by an adult. All horses will be charged a non-refundable office fee of \$25 per horse. All horses or ponies must have either a horse ID number issued from US Equestrian Federation or a breed registration number in order to show. This number must be listed on the entry blank.

POST ENTRIES - Entries postmarked after May 24, 2024, will be charged a post entry fee of \$25 per horse. This will be in addition to all other normal fees. Horses and/or ponies must be entered in a class or will be considered a post entry. Entries will be accepted up to one hour before the scheduled start of each session. An unsigned open check mailed with entries will be considered as a post entry. Entries without payment will also be considered a post entry and late fees will apply.

EMERGENCY ENTRIES - In cases where entries cannot be made at least one hour before the scheduled start of each session, an emergency penalty of \$30.00 will be charged for each class in addition to all other fees.

STALL FEES are \$125.00 per stall. All stalls are permanent with full doors. Stalls will be ready for occupancy on Tuesday, June 4, 2024, at 8:00 am. Arrangements can be made for earlier arrival through the Manager at an additional fee of \$20.00 per day per stall. Stall fees must accompany entry form. EXTRA CHARGES FOR REMOVAL OR ALTERING DOORS. A \$30 per horse grounds fee will be charged for all horses showing out of a trailer.

INITIAL BEDDING will NOT be provided. Only bag shavings (\$9.00/bag) will be available for purchase from the showthrough the horse show office. Bedding can be ordered by filling out the space provided on the entry blank and your bedding will be at your stalls when you arrive. You may call LIZ HOLMES @ 919-672-3741 prior to the week of the show. Feed and hay will be available. Please note on entry blank your arrival date and time. NEITHER BEDDING NOR FEED MAY BE BROUGHT IN BY AN OUTSIDE VENDOR. Neither bark nor sawdust will be allowed to behauled in from the outside. If an outside vendor hauls in bedding or feed for a client of his, he will be charged a show vendor fee. Persons wanting to bring their own bedding may do so but must haul it in ontheir own vehicles. **Should any unused bags of shavings need to be returned, a re-stocking fee of \$5.00 per bag will be charged.**

HORSE SHOW OFFICE will close one hour prior to the scheduled starting time of each performance for taking entries for that performance. Any scratches after this time will be accepted but entries fees will be retained. An emergency entry fee of \$30.00 per class added will be charged in addition to the normal entry fee.

REFUNDS of Entry Fees will only be made upon presentation of a certificate of illness issued by a veterinarian on an official letterhead stating illness or lameness. Fees will be refunded minus a \$20.00 scratch horse fee, the non-refundable office fee per horse and the post entry fee. Requests for stall refunds after May 29, 2024, will not be honored.

EMERGENCY REFUND POLICY in the event all or part of the competition is cancelled due to a storm, accident or other emergency. If the competition is cancelled prior to the scheduled first day of the horse show all fees will be refunded in full minus the non-refundable office fee. Stall fees will not be refunded after May 29, 2024. If classes are cancelled once the competition has begun, entry fees for remaining classes will be refunded.

THE BLOWING ROCK CHARITY HORSE SHOW will not be held liable for any accident, loss, damage or injury that may occur to any Exhibitor, Owner, Trainer, Agent, Groom, Individual or Spectator sustained while at the Blowing Rock Charity Horse Show. This shall be incorporated as a condition of entry or admittance to the Show.

ACCOUNTS: All accounts must be paid at the Horse Show Office before entry numbers will be given out. A signed, open check must be left for each account in the office prior to packets being distributed. An unsigned, open check sent in with entries will be cause to consider entries as post entries. The Horse Show office WILL NOT be open on Monday following the show. Accounts must be settled before the last class of the Sunday afternoon performance. **Anyone failing to settle their account will relinquish the right for adjustments. It will be to youradvantage to check over your account before filling in your check.**

VAN AND TRAILER PARKING WILL BE OFF-SITE. Get map and site location of trailers and vans at horse show office. Motor Homes or Campers will be charged \$50.00 per day. ON-SITE CAMPERS AND MOTOR HOMES ARE ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS.

NORTH CAROLINA requires a negative "Coggins" Certificate, within 12 months of entering or leaving the State. ALL HORSES MUST HAVE CURRENT COGGINS TEST. A COPY MUST BE KEPT WITH HORSE. A copy must also be sent with entries and left on file in the horse show office.

THREE ENTRIES are required to fill a class. Fewer than three may be cause for cancellation or combining the class, at the option of the management.

USEF FEE & DRUG FEE: USEF Federation fee \$23.00 (\$15.00 Drug & Medication, \$8.00 USEF).

REGISTRATION PAPERS: A copy of Registration Papers showing current ownership must accompany each horse and/or pony entered in the American Saddlebred Division, the Hackney/Hackney Harness Pony division. WE MUST KEEP A COPY ON FILE IN THE SHOW OFFICE AND THESE COPIES WILL NOT BE RETURNED. Numbers will not be released for an entry in these divisions without the proper proof of registration. Names of horses/ ponies must be on the Entry Form. The word "Entry" may not be used. All horses/ponies must be entered in their full registered name and number and in the current owner of record.

PRIZE MONEY will be mailed within 30 days after the close of the show. Prize money will be credited to the agent's account. Persons wishing to receive their own prize money must send in separate entry blank with current agent information listed including social security number.

RETURNED CHECKS will be charged a \$50.00 return check fee.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT: By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the Blowing Rock Saddlebred Horse Show (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber, I acknowledge that I will be enrolled for no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew in USEF's sole discretion. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice. USEF may in its sole discretion, at any time, terminate my USEF Fan status.

QUESTIONS not covered by the Rules of the US Equestrian Federation shall be decided by Show Management.

FOOTING in the Show Ring is a dirt base with mixed sand. Size of ring is 120 x 240'. Two warm-up rings are provided. Size of these are 120' x 238' and the 2nd is 110'x 220'. The warm-up ringshave excellent footing and each has a similar base as the main show ring.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may bedeemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule:

1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

2024 BLOWING ROCK SADDLEBRED HORSE SHOW ACADEMY RULES

Show Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally or cancel any entries of any exhibitor at its discretion and require horses and entrants to vacate the premises at its discretion and without liability.

Academy entries are to follow all horse show entry rules.

The following rules must be followed. If violations are determined by Show Management, ALL ENTRIES from the offending barn will be disqualified and asked to leave the showgrounds.

Safety is of the utmost importance! Unruly, out of control or disruptive horses will be excused.

Saturday Afternoon Entry Fee: \$30.00 6 Places

Riders

- Riders are to be enrolled in a professionally run lesson program.
- Once riders show in regular performance classes, they are no longer eligible to show in Academy classes. However, returning riders are eligible for WTC Academy classes after a 10-year absence from the show ring.
- Riders who have shown in a regular division, or in a suit/coat, are no longer eligible to show in Academy classes, with the exception of Show Rider classes.
- Riders who have shown/been judged in WTC classes are no longer eligible to return to WT classes.
- Riders who have shown/been judged in WT classes are no longer eligible to show in Lead Line.
- Riders may not show in any performance division at the same show (except driving or in hand classes), with the exception of Show Riders.
- Age of the rider is determined by their age as of December 1 of the previous year.
- NO earpieces allowed on riders in the show ring. If rider is hearing impaired, medical documentation must be produced for Show Management.
- Riders who show in "elite" classes at other shows must enter the Show Rider classes since they are considered advanced riders.

Horses

- Horses must be regularly used as lesson horses.
- While it is preferred that horses are owned by instructors, horses may be owned or leased by riders **IF** they are used regularly by others as a lesson/school horse.
- Horses shown in Academy classes cannot be in show training with a professional. This includes horses on consignment. Horses should not have been professionally trained within 60 days of show.
- Horses should be plain shod. (Exception may be made if corrective shoeing is needed, one pad and/or wedge is allowed for the comfort of the horse.) The definition of "show package" will be determined by Show Management, with help from Show Farrier if needed.
- Hoof blacking is optional; no ribbon braiding allowed.
- School horses may cross enter into regular show classes at the same show.
- Academy classes are open to mares and geldings of any breed.

Tack

- Horses are to be tacked with saddle consistent with style of riding (saddle seat, hunt seat, western).
- Full or Pelham bridles or snaffle bridle with martingale. A martingale on a leverage bit is prohibited.
- Wraps, splint boots, bell boots are permitted if needed for the safety of the horse and in driving classes. No blinkers
 allowed in under saddle classes.

Attire

To be appropriate for the style of riding/driving.

- Jodhpurs, breeches, dark pants, long sleeve shirt, with collar, tie, gloves, vest (sweater permissible in very cold weather) Riding suits and jackets are prohibited. Chaps and western hats are prohibited.
- Roweled spurs are not permitted.
- All riders 17 years of age & under MUST wear protective headgear that meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards. However, all riders are encouraged to wear protective headgear.

Judging

- Exhibitors are to be judged on their skill to effectively control the horse and to show the horse to its best advantage.
- Horsemanship/Showmanship classes are judged on the rider's performance ability how well they show the horse and
 utilize the ring including correct diagonals and leads. Diagonals will count, no backing. Riders' ability to show is paramount.
- Equitation classes are to be judged on a rider's basic equitation skills riding on correct leads and diagonals, conveying the impression of effective and easy control.
- Horses are not to back, perform an extended trot, or a hand gallop.
- Headers are permitted in the line-up for the 10 & under riders; no towels or whips allowed.
- The horse IS NOT to be judged.

Descriptions

- Pattern Classes No rail work, entries to work the pattern individually.
- Novice Rider Classes open to Academy riders who have not won 3 classes in their respective divisions (WT & WTC). This will be on the "Honor System" as winter tournaments/barn show results are not recorded.
- Green Rider Classes open to Academy riders in their 1st year of showing
- Show Rider Classes for advanced Academy riders or amateur/junior exhibitor riders with prior show ring experience. A Show Rider may not return to regular Academy classes.
- Academy Driving Showmanship/Reinsmanship Classes Open to any amateur or junior exhibitors. Drivers may not cross
 enter into other driving classes at the same show but may cross enter into under saddle performance classes or other
 Academy classes. Academy driver may be accompanied in the cart by an experienced adult who is not allowed to coach.
 Only a 2-wheel cart/buggy is permitted in driving classes.
- WT Lead Line (8 & Under) Riders will be led in at the walk and worked each way of the ring. They will trot individually past the judge. Riders are expected to post but correct diagonals are not required. Class will be judged.

Class Splits

Should class splits be necessary, the rider's age and classification (A-Advanced, B-Beginner, C-Intermediate) **must** be listed on the entry form. Entries made without split information will automatically be entered into the Advanced sections.

- Classes should have no more than 15 entries.
- 10 & Under WT/8 & Under WT will split at 10 entries.
- 6 & Under WT will split at 6 entries.

Academy WTC Pattern Options

WTC PATTERN #1

- Trot down the rail to the center of the turn. Halt.
- Canter one (1) circle on the correct lead. Halt. Reverse.
- Trot one (1) circle on the correct diagonal.
- Continue trotting down the rail, showing one (1) change of diagonal at the midpoint of the rail.
- Exit the arena at a trot. WTC PATTERN #2
- Enter the arena and trot down the right straightaway, showing two (2) changes of diagonal. Begin on the right diagonal.
- Continue trotting to the center of the end of the ring. Halt.
- Canter a circle on the left lead. Halt.
- Trot from the center of the turn down the next straightaway on the right diagonal.
- Exit the arena without stopping.

Academy WT Pattern Options WT PATTERN #1

- Enter the arena at a trot, beginning on the right diagonal. Trot three-fourths (3/4) of the way down the straightaway, showing one (1) change of diagonal. Halt.
- Trot a two (2) loop serpentine across the width of the arena and continue to trot around the end of the ring.
- Continue to trot the straightaway showing two (2) changes of diagonal.
- Exit the arena at a trot without stopping.

WT PATTERN #2

- Enter the arena and trot down the rail to the left showing two (2) changes of diagonal, beginning on the left diagonal.
- Continue trotting through the turn and execute a circle at the beginning of the next straightaway. Halt.
- Pick up a trot on the right diagonal. Change to the left diagonal at thew halfway point of the straightaway.
- Continue trotting to the end of the straightaway and exit the arena.
